2. Getting to know your Waybox

Waybox is the innovative home charger that makes your charging experience smart, reliable, and cost-effective.

This manual will guide you through the main features of your Waybox, so you can get the most out of your charging experience.

3. Waybox Modes

Warning: Before using your Waybox, we encourage you to follow all the steps to connect it to your Enel X Way account (as outlined in the Getting Online section). This will allow you to remotely schedule and start charging sessions, configure the power level, receive live notifications, get remote technical support, keep track of charging sessions and more.

Waybox allows you to charge in two modes: Connect & Charge or Unlock To Charge.

3.1 Connect & Charge Mode

Note: This mode is suggested when the Waybox is installed in areas with reserved access for the user.

This mode does not require any authentication before starting and ending a charging session. However, this mode does not allow for smart charging features (e.g. delayed and scheduled charging).

- > To start charging, simply plug in your vehicle.
- > To stop charging, send a stop command (from the Enel X Way App or from the vehicle) and then unplug your vehicle.

Waybox uses the Connect & Charge Mode by default.

Note: This mode is suggested when the Waybox is installed in areas with reserved access for the user.

3.2 Unlock To Charge Mode

Note: This mode is recommended when the charger is installed in areas with public access and when using the smart charging features. With scheduled charging, you can set up a recurring charging schedule, choosing the duration and days of the week. This feature is accessible through the Enel X Way App, and from the main screen of your Waybox. For more information on the feature and what you can do with the Enel X Way App, please refer to the app's Use Instructions and FAQs, available on our Support Hub.

In Unlock To Charge Mode, the Waybox only charges when it recognizes an authorized user. This means that charging sessions are started and stopped using either an authorized Enel X Way App account or a RFID card.

4. Getting Online

Your Waybox can be connected to Enel X Way smart charging platform through either a Wi-Fi or cellular internet connection. This allows you to control your Waybox anytime, from anywhere, using the Enel X Way App.

The Enel X Way App is available on the <u>iOS App Store</u> and <u>Google Play Store</u>.

4.1 Getting Waybox online using cellular connectivity

Note: This configuration only applies to "Cellular" products

1. After launching the app, on the bottom of the of the main page, select Home



2. Select **START CONFIGURATION.**



3. Scan or insert the serial number of your Enel X Way Waybox™. Once done, click on the **arrow** to proceed.

Note: The serial number is on the label on the right side of your Enel X Way Waybox™.



4. Select Add via cellular connectivity and click CONTINUE to proceed.



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5. In the configuration screen, follow the steps below, then click on the **arrow** to proceed.

- > Enter a unique name for your Waybox.
- > Check the physical address of your Waybox (modify the address if it is not correct).
- > Select the default power level of your Waybox.

4. Select Configure new charger with Wi-Fi and click CONTINUE to proceed.

3. Scan or insert the serial number of your Waybox. Once done, click on the **arrow** to proceed.

Note: The serial number is on the label on the side of your Waybox.



4. Select "Configure a new charger with Wi-Fi" and then CONTINUE to confirm.



5. The chargers connected to your network are listed on the screen. Select the charger to proceed.



6. Enter the PIN code needed to complete the process, then **ADD TO ACCOUNT.** The PIN code should be shared by the user who first associated the Waybox to his/her account.



Note: The PIN code can be retrieved at any time by a user already associated in the settings menu of the Waybox, in the section **Sharing.**

5. Charging your vehicle

5.1 Connect & Charge Mode

This section describes how to charge a vehicle with a Waybox set in Connect & Charge mode.

To start charging, connect your vehicle to the Waybox:

- > **Cable version:** Connect the Waybox charging cable to your vehicle
- > Socket version: Connect your charging cable to the Waybox Socket and to your vehicle.

Charging starts automatically. Use the Enel X Way App to monitor your charging session. To do this, access the Home section.



To stop charging, send a STOP command from your vehicle, then disconnect your vehicle from the Waybox.

5.2 Unlock To Charge Mode

This section describes how to charge a vehicle with a Waybox set in Unlock To Charge mode, using either Enel X Way App or a RFID card.

USING THE ENEL X WAY APP TO START CHARGING IMMEDIATELY

To start charging, access the **Home** section on the Enel X Way App and press **UNLOCK.**



(as is screen)

Plug in your vehicle within 90 seconds to start charging.

- > Cable version: Connect the Waybox charging cable to your vehicle
- > Socket version: Connect your charging cable to the Waybox Socket and to your vehicle

Charging starts automatically. Once started, you can monitor your charging session on the screen.



To stop charging, select **STOP CHARGING** on the Enel X Way App. Charging stops automatically and the charging cable can be removed.

Note: It is also possible to issue a STOP command from the vehicle.

USING A RFID CARD TO START CHARGING IMMEDIATELY

Note: You can associate an RFID card with your account at any time, in **My Account > Enel X Way Card** section and by following the steps on screen.

- > The Enel X Way Card will allow you to start your charging session if:Waybox has been paired with your Enel X Way account (as indicated in the Getting Online section).
- > Unlock to Charge mode has been selected.
- > Enel X Way Card has been paired with your Enel X Way account.

To start a charging session, tap your card against the RFID reader on the Waybox. Plug in your vehicle within 90 seconds of RFID authorization:

- > Cable version: Connect the Waybox charging cable to your vehicle
- > Socket version: Connect your charging cable to the Waybox Socket and to your vehicle

Charging starts automatically. Use the Enel X Way App to monitor your charging session. To do this, access the **Home** section.



To stop charging, tap your card against the RFID reader on the Waybox. Charging stops automatically and the charging cable can be removed.

Note: It is also possible to issue a STOP command (from the Enel X Way App or from the vehicle).

6. Charging history

To see the history of the completed charging sessions, in the navigation bar select History.

In the **Home** section, you can view your account's history of charging sessions made with your paired Waybox.

9. The colour of sustainability

Your Waybox Plus and Pro has been produced with recycled plastic materials derived from the recycling of the ENEL group's meter shells that are being discarded.

The special manufacturing process foresees that the recycled plastic materials are mixed with materials loaded with glass fibre to guarantee mechanical, thermal and fire resistance equal or superior to an equivalent production deriving from the use of virgin polymer.

This may result in different colour shades on the manufactured components, due to possible differences already present on the parts entering the recovery chain and the variability of dispersion of the glass fibres to ensure mechanical and thermal resistance.

Small nuances, variations in tone or texture in no way affect the safety, quality and durability of your Waybox.
